Rules of Participation

Participation is open to all artists, 18 years of age or older. All work must be original and of the artist's own creation. **Artists under the age of 18 may be allowed provided a parent or guardian is present at the event.*

Prints and mechanical offset reproductions, such as calendars, note cards, and stationary, are allowed, but intent to display them must be clearly stated on the application. Prints must be properly signed and numbered.

No food products may be sold.

Booth structure and displays must not exceed a 10'x10' space. Artists must be present during the entire event.

Exhibit Space

Exhibit space is assigned by the ArtSee Coordinator. Artists are responsible for providing their own tables, linens, easels, and displays. Space allotment is approximately 10'x10' but may vary. Special requests will be considered. Storage must be neatly concealed within or around the exhibit space. Electricity is available, but must be requested in the application.

Setup will take place beginning at 4pm on May 6th, 2016. All setup must be completed by 4:45pm on May 6th, 2016. **If you need extended time please contact us.*

Security is not available. All work is displayed at the artists' own risk. The Empire Arts Center and the Greater Grand Forks Young Professionals are not liable for damage to or theft of artwork.

Artist Statement

Artists must submit a statement of 500 words or less describing themselves and their artwork. The statement will be provided to the selection committee and, for invited artists, posted on the ArtSee website. Please include information describing what materials and processes are used in creating the work.

Images

Artists must submit five images of their artwork and one to three images of the display setup (if available). These images will be provided to the selection committee and, for invited artists, posted on the ArtSee website.

All images should be a minimum of 300KB and a maximum of 20MB and submitted as a .jpg, .png, or .pdf file type. Images saved in file formats other than those listed will not be accepted. Only digital images will be allowed. Images should be emailed to VP@ggfy.com.

Selection Process

To ensure a high standard of excellence is maintained, a panel of individuals silently and independently reviews applications for originality, creativity, quality, and display. Applicants with the highest scores are invited to participate. All artists will be notified of their status via email on or before March 10, 2015.

Application Fee

A non-refundable processing fee of \$25 is due with the application. All artists must fill out an application and submit their \$25 fee by check on or before April 15th, 2016. One application per artist.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations must be submitted in writing on or before April 29th, 2016. Application fees will not be refunded.
